The chart above shows the comparison from 2010 to 2011 in the number of students playing in CR's fall sports in three categories:

1. 9th grade - Because all 9th grade teams were eliminated this year.
2. 10th grade - To see if there were impacts to 10th graders since most 9th and 10th graders would be competing for spots on the JV teams. There was an impact at North, but at South, more 10th graders played this year than last year.
3. Overall totals at both schools - For the first time since South was built, its population has exceeded North's.

Citizens looked at all fall sports because students who might have been cut from JV have the opportunity to be on CR's no-cut teams. These 9th grade participation numbers must be looked at in the context of a decline of 115 students in the 9th grade enrollment from 2010 to 2011 (65 at North and 50 at South).
